

KEYBOARD SHORTCUTS

This is a list of the currently supported keyboard shortcuts in AP Pro. The Mac shortcuts are listed at the end.

Key	Description
Tab and Shift + Tab	Moves the focus to the next or previous element. If the element is an entry field, the cursor is placed into the field. Disabled elements are skipped.
Arrow up and arrow down	Moves the cursor from one item to another in lists and tree views, and from one row to another inside a grid. Moves between single radio buttons in a radio button group.
Arrow left and arrow right	Moves the cursor within a field when the field is selected, from one cell to another inside a grid, and from tab to another.
Enter	Selects a link, equals to clicking a button, opens a context menu, or starts a search. With check boxes and radio buttons, selects/unselects the item.
Esc	Closes the dialog (same as Cancel). If the focus is on an element that also closes with Esc (for example, a drop-down list), the first Esc closes the drop-down list and the second Esc closes the dialog.
Shift + mouse click	Highlights clicked rows and all rows in between.
Shift + up and down arrows	Starts selecting or deselecting rows starting from the focused row.
Ctrl + mouse click	Selects all clicked rows.
Ctrl + A	Selects all rows.
Delete	Deletes the content of the selected cell.
Ctrl + C	Copies cell.
Ctrl + Shift + C	Copies row(s).
Ctrl + Shift + Delete	Deletes row.
Alt + I	Adds rows in editable grids.
Ctrl + V	Pastes cell or row (depending on which has been copied).
Home	Moves to the first cell of the grid.
End	Moves to the last cell of the grid (but not to actions column).

In Mac computers	
Ctrl + C	Copies cell.
Cmd + V	Pastes cell.
Ctrl + Shift + C	Copies row.
Ctrl + V	Pastes row.
Ctrl + Shift + Fn + Del	Deletes row.
Backspace	Deletes the content of the selected cell.
Ctrl + A	Selects all rows.
